EDWIN WILLIAM (ED) EVANS

Born June 26, 1937 in Anniston, Alabama. Moved to Birmingham, Alabama at age 2. Graduated from Auburn University with a Mechanical Engineering Degree in March, 1960. Joined the U.S. Navy in April, 1960, and was discharged in September, 1965.

Arriving in Greenville, my wife and I went to a place called Tramps every chance we could get. I danced, was a stock holder, and managed the Sand Flea for three years. The Sand Flea closed in 1993. I am still a member of the Carolina Shag Club.

I have traveled from Virginia to Florida and west to Memphis for Shag events. In 1995, I bought a house at North Myrtle Beach so I could come to the Shag world anytime I wanted. I have been attending ShagAttack since 1984.

I met my first wife, Julie, dancing in Pensacola, Florida. She died in 1997 as a member of the Shaggers Hall of Fame. I met my present wife, Elyse, at a Spring SOS. We were married in 2001. Many of the friendships I started years ago have become close relationships that have lasted to this day.
